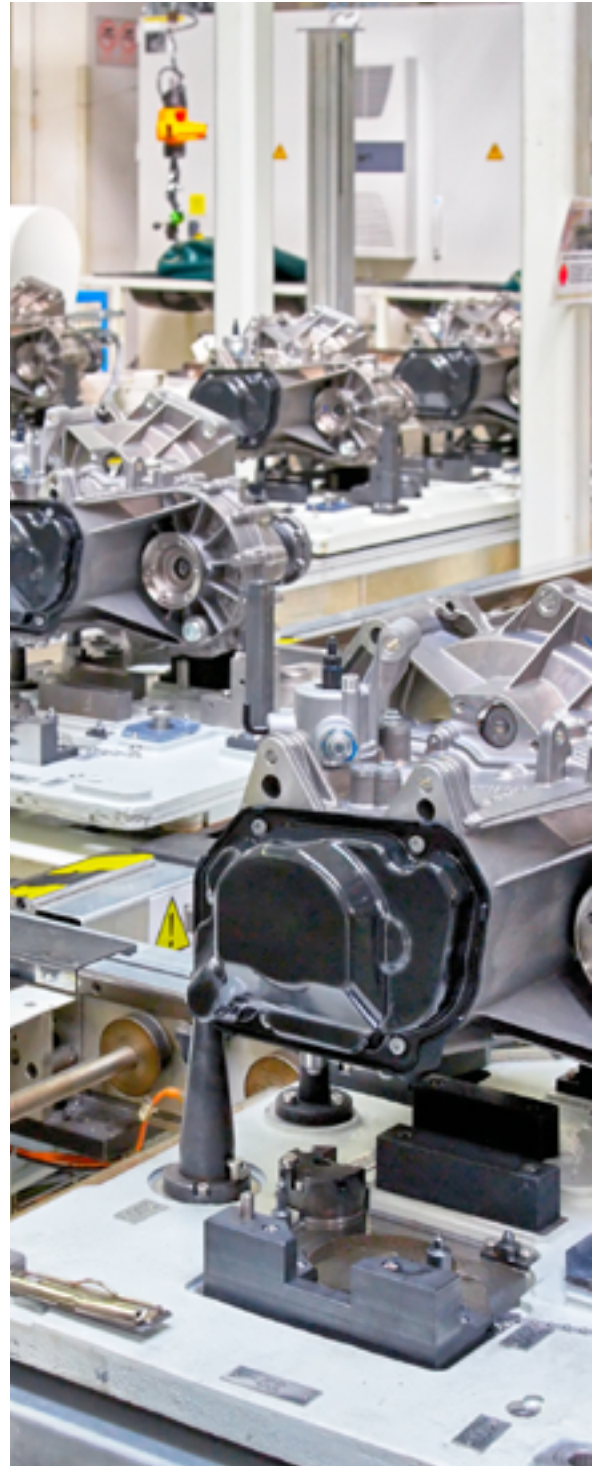


FROMM'S TOP 5 THINGS MANUFACTURERS SHOULD KNOW DURING THE COVID-19 SHUTDOWN

- 1) You WILL have Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) failures**
 - Due to extended power off times, preparations should be made to be ready for drive failures upon power up
 - Make sure all VFD projects are backed up and saved
 - Ensure you have a 1203-USB cable for Rockwell VFD backups
 - Download Free CCW software [here](#)
- 2) You WILL have PLC failures**
 - PLC batteries that have not been replaced frequently will cause program loss
 - Take measures to ensure programs are backed up and saved

- 3) Production will need to come online quickly**
 - Now is the time to perform preventative maintenance to ensure a smooth startup
 - Take this time to ensure personnel is properly trained for startup failures

 - Schedule maintenance teams into your facility at least two days prior to plant startup
